Generic Safety Case(s)

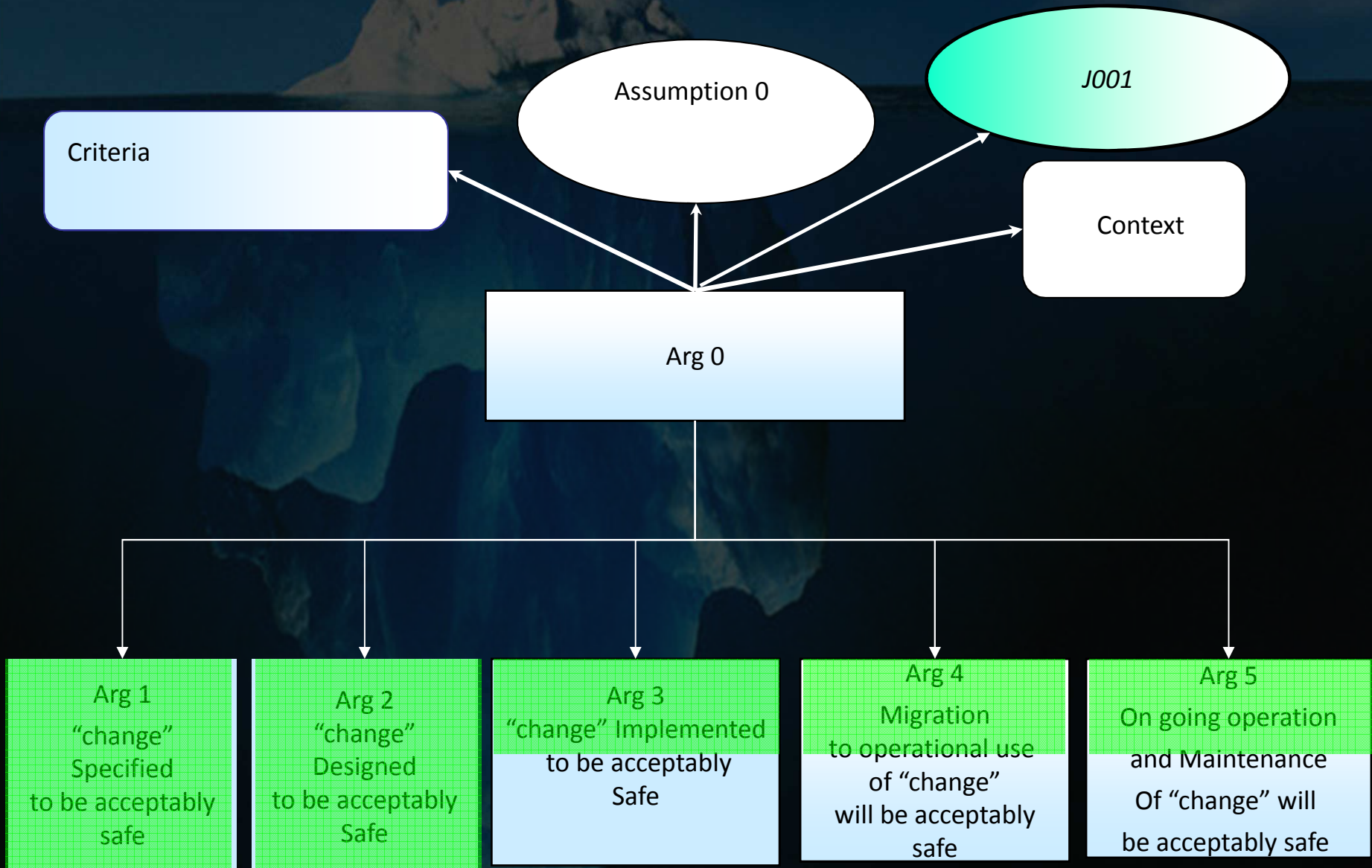
- Produced to support the definition of new systems

- Need to take environment of operations into account

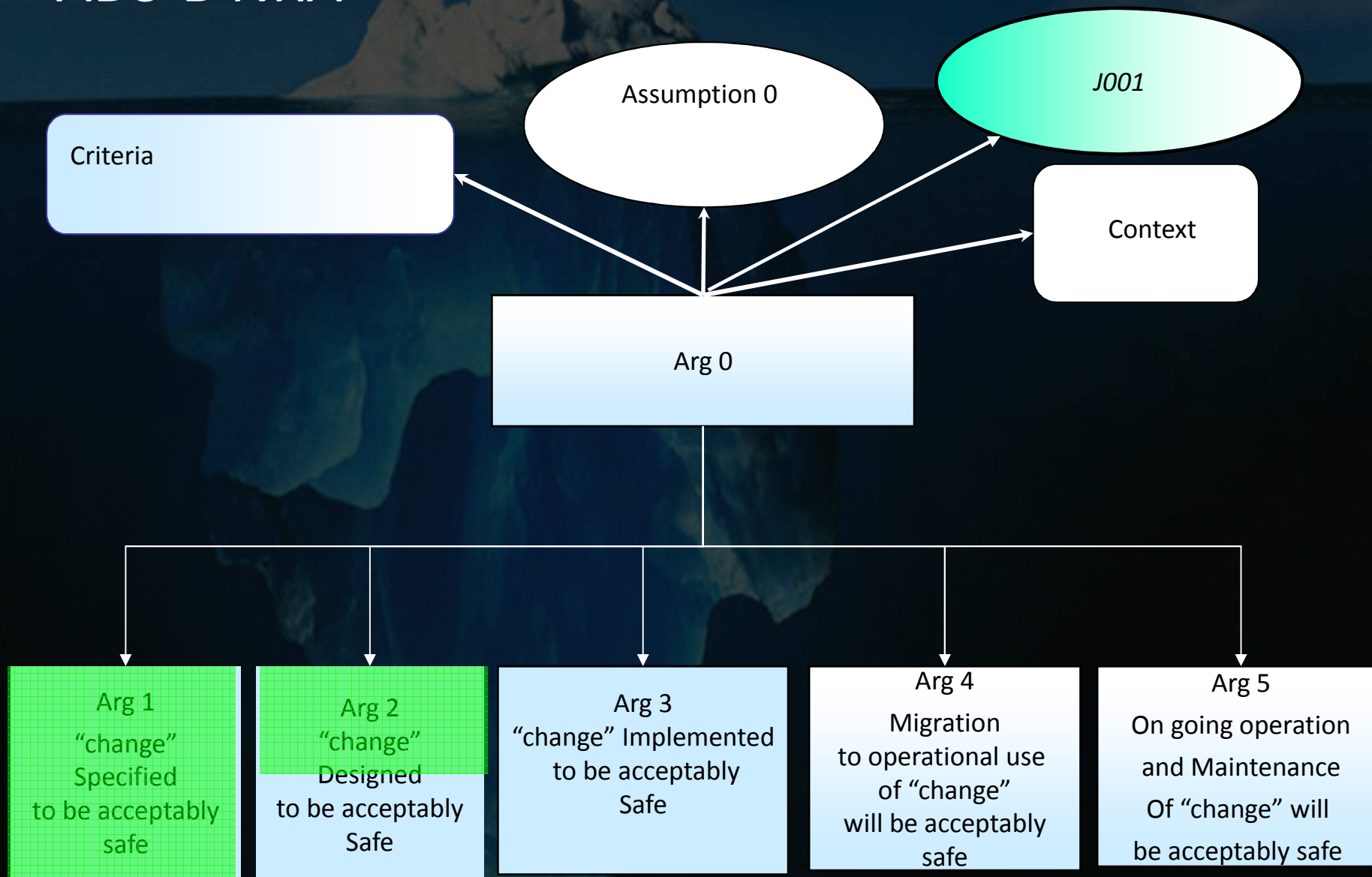

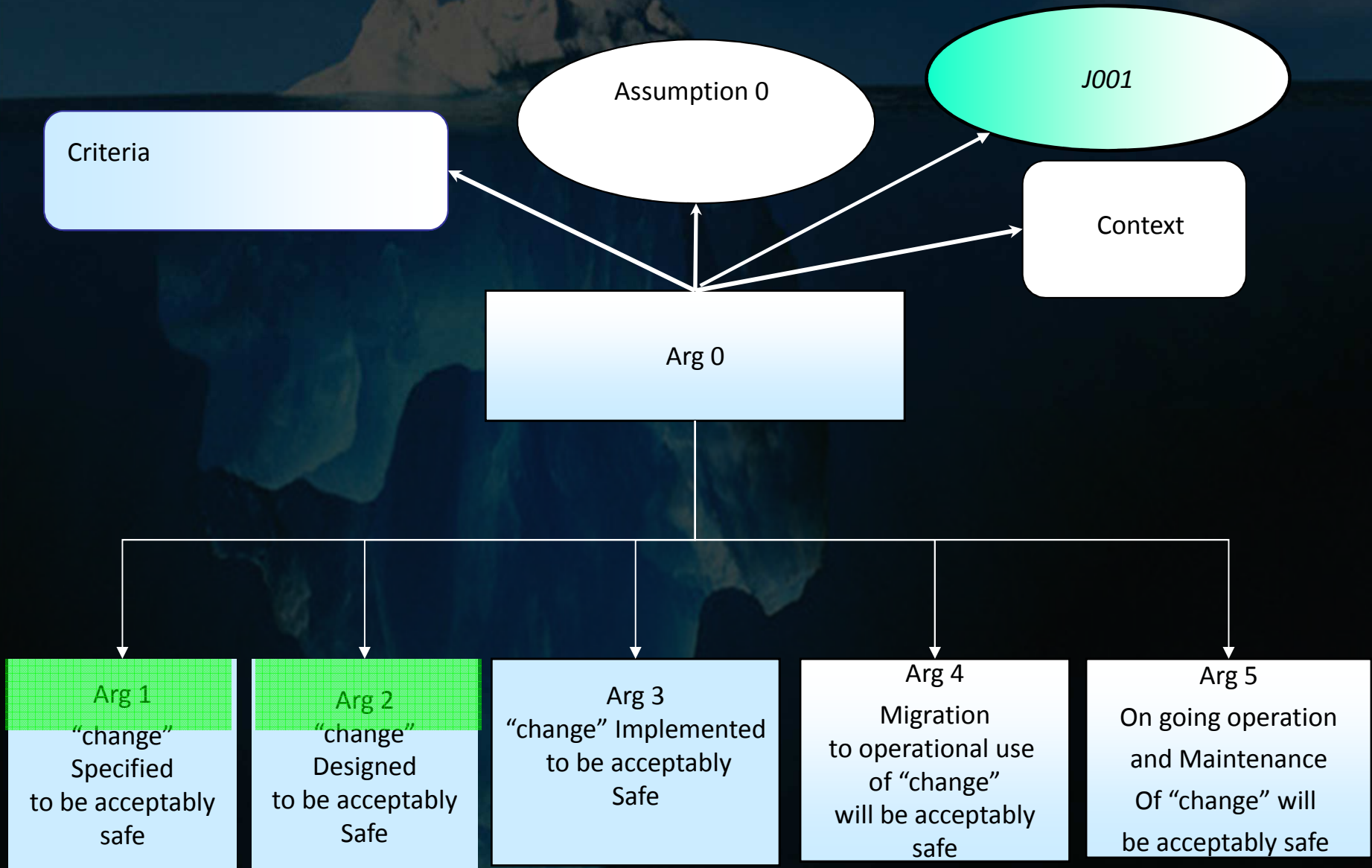
