Workload shall be assessed as low, medium or high based on the following:

Low: workload is lower than 70% of average traffic for the analysed period

Medium: workload is between 70% and 120% of the average traffic for the analysed period

High: workload is higher than 120% of the average traffic for the analysed period

The score will be **PASS/NOT PASSED**.

To determine the result, the following criterion shall be used:

- One cannot be rated with **2** for more than 3 items in order to consider the evaluation as PASSED
- No item can be rated with 1 in order to consider the evaluation as PASSED

Notes:

- (1) The PASS score in this evaluation is not valid for the revalidation of the Unit endorsement.
- (2) A controller with a NO PASS score in this evaluation will carry out Specific Training to reach the minimum required objectives/standard.
